A Guatemalan torture survivor speaks out on violence, impunity, and immigration reform

The Guatemala Human Rights Commission hosts Gladys Monterroso, a Guatemalan lawyer, university professor, and secretary for Congresswomen Nineth Montenegro. Gladys was kidnapped and tortured in March 2009.
